2 Teaching Courses

4 WFN Teaching Centers

The WFN Teaching Centers fulfill the mission to train neurologists regionally.

To qualify as a WFN Teaching Center, a center has to undergo an evaluation, a visit of the education committee and provide a detailed description of its activities. At present, there are three teaching centers in Africa (Cairo, Dakar and Rabat) and one in Central America (Mexico).

Trainees are supported by the WFN in Fellowship and training programs at these Teaching Centers.
